

Savour the panoramic vistas of Mount Hekla and the surrounding countryside staying at the charming Hotel Fluðir from where you can enjoy South Iceland's most famous attractions. A stone's throw away are Gullfoss, Geysir and Pingvellir and two stones' throw away Mýrdalsjökull, Skógafoss and Dyrhólæy.

HOTEL FLUÐIR

Owned and run by Margret Runolfsdottir the Fluðir has an intriguing architectural V shaped design over a single floor so that each and every room opens on to a grass courtyard from its own terrace. A dining room with a panoramic view of the local countryside; comfortable bar, lobby and quirky art give it a special charm. All 32 rooms have private WC/bath tub, telephone & TV.



Highlights of the South



HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SOUTH

DAY 1 UK- REYKJAVÍK Scheduled flight to Reykjavík. Collect hire car at the airport, drive to and overnight at Hotel Fluðir for 4 nights.

DAY 2 THE SOUTH COAST After breakfast, drive along the coast stopping at Seljalandsfoss and Skógafoss on the way to Dyrhólæy's bird cliffs and black sand beaches.

DAY 3 EYRABAKKI & STOKKSEYRI Visit the greenhouse village of Hveragerði, a sort of giant geothermally heated garden centre - even the local church has tiny geysers spouting alongside it. Afterwards pop down to the coast and Eyrbakki, a colourful little place with rather more traditional clapboard buildings than the average Icelandic village and to Stokkseyri, rounding off your day with a plate of lobster in the village's waterside restaurant.

DAY 4 GEYSIR-GULLFOSS After breakfast, drive up to the Geysir area where Strokkur spouts impressively every 5 to 10 minutes, alongside of which there are steaming fumaroles, hot springs and pools, some a dark muddy grey and others a translucent turquoise. Then on to Gullfoss, the

golden waterfall, where the glacial river Hvítá plummets 32 metres before twisting and tumbling down a gorge marking the junction of Tectonic plates. End your day with a visit to pingvellir, always mystically beautiful but particularly tranquil in late afternoon when the day tour visitors have left.

DAY 5 REYKJAVÍK - UK After breakfast drive along the moss clad lava Reykjanes peninsula to the Blue Lagoon for a valedictory bathe before, dropping your car off at the airport and return flight to UK.
